The [Home from home report](#) provides an understanding of perceptions of the quality of dementia care provided in [care homes](#). It also recommends action to bring the quality of all homes up to that of the best.

## Key findings

- Two thirds of care home residents have some form of [dementia](#)
- Some homes provide excellent care. Many homes are still not providing the level of person centred care people with dementia deserve
- There are still some issues with the provision of activities and occupation

- Many care home residents with dementia are not being with dignity and respect they deserve
