- 6 stage route, each approximately 40-45 miles
- Energy snack stops, 2 hot meal stops
- Take on the ride as an individual
- Ride with a partner, or your own team to support each other
- Fully signed route, maps & GPS downloads
- A hero's celebration as you cross the finish line in London!
