

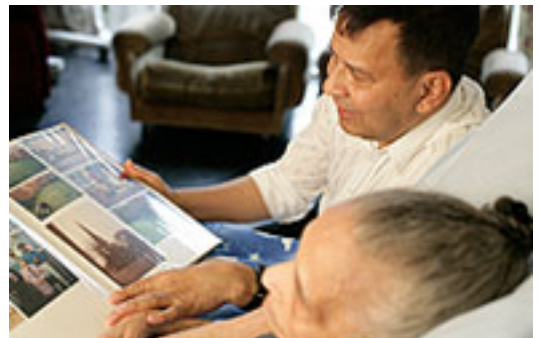
# Help us improve dementia services in Wales
