Vision:

Everyone with dementia is able to access good quality health and care support at a fair price



Some of the changes we need to see:

Dementia Fund established with annual funding to ensure dementia premium covered

Dementia Connect rolled out so that everyone diagnosed with dementia can access support with an Adviser: quality and consistency. An end to the postcode lottery of care

High quality, effective training mandated for all health and care staff to support the delivery of good quality, specialist dementia care

Social insurance system to pool risk across society

Best practices in care research and assisted technology (outputs of Centers of Excellence and DRI) implemented

Priority – Research: an end to dementia and hope for the future



Vision:

Higher numbers of people diagnosed with dementia, with timely, accurate diagnosis and the ability to access a condition changing treatment

New, nationally agreed model of calculating dementia prevalence and improvements in the scope, collection and collation of dementia data

Increased investment and development in dementia research to match other conditions, with greater numbers of researchers working in the field
