



1 Pick a date and invite your friends.



2 Prep some snacks and choose which games to play.



3 Set up a Just Giving page at [justgiving.com](https://www.justgiving.com) to collect donations.

4 Ask for a donation from everyone joining, we suggest £10 each.

5 Place your collection box on the table.

Make sure it's near the Gift Aid form so we can claim an extra 25% from eligible donations.

6 It's game on! Roll the dice and make your move.

7 Who deserves the glory? Who's the biggest loser?

Hand out the stickers to deserving players.

9 Pay in your donations. See the back of your Gift Aid form to find out how.



Here's how to host your **Games Night.**

The more you raise, the bigger difference we can make to the lives of everyone affected by dementia

1. Cheat stickers: Add some fun to your evening by introducing cheat stickers. Those desperate to win can donate an extra £5, to allow them an extra go (or to skip a go depending on what game you're playing). You can download extra cheat cards at alzheimers.org.uk/gamesnight.



2. Loser fine: We want everyone to have fun at your Games Night, but to encourage that competitive spirit, why not impose a loser fine. At the end of each game, ask the loser to pop some extra spare change in the collection box.



3. Add some extra 'pay to enter' games on top of the others you have selected. Here are our favourites:

Roll the Coin: Try and get a bottle of wine or spirit donated and place it in the centre of an empty floor. Whoever rolls their £2 coin closest to the bottle wins it and you keep the coins!



Heads or tails: People pay £2 to play. Participants either choose heads by putting their hands on their head, or tails by putting their hands on their bottom and the host flips a coin. Those who choose the correct side stay standing and those who get it wrong, sit down. Keep playing and the last person standing wins a prize and the donations will go towards fundraising.
