



Spotlight on Dementia: 2021- 2022 Terms and Conditions

1. Alzheimer's Society, 43-44 Crutched Friars, London, EC3N 2AE ("the Society") is the promoter of the competition.
2. By entering the competition, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
3. The competition is free to enter. To be eligible you must be associated with an Alzheimer's Society research grant that was active as of 22 November 2021. If you aren't sure about eligibility or have questions about your entry, please contact us at **imagecomp@alzheimers.org.uk** Entries submitted by you on behalf of a team are permitted, although please note that there is a limit of one prize in each category.
4. Entrants can enter more than one entry into each category and/or enter the same entry into multiple categories (if your entry is eligible in those categories). However, please note that entrants will only be able to win once overall for one of their entries.
5. **All entries must be received by no later than 23:59 on 1 April 2022.** All competition entries received after the closing date and time are automatically disqualified.
6. The shortlisted competition entries will be judged by a panel of judges expected to take place in or before June 2022. The decision of the panel of judges will be final.
7. The prize for the winning entry in each category will be a trophy. The prize for the winner of the competition will be a trophy and an EcoTank ET-8500 photo printer, courtesy of Epson, worth approximately £650.
8. The Society will contact the winners as soon as practicable after the judges have judged the competition entries, using the contact number or email address provided with the competition entry.
9. The Society will publish the name and either the institution or UK county of prize winners on its website as soon as practicable after 29 June 2022.  - (b) There are no conflicting agreements or restrictions in place that restrict usage of your entry or other submissions in accordance with these terms and conditions (including with your institution, if applicable) and you confirm that you have the ability to grant the licence in condition 10 above;
 - (c) You have all gained all required consents, agreements, permissions and waivers to use any third-party images or material for the purposes of your entry and these terms and conditions. If a third-party image is of a person under 18, parental or guardian consent must be provided; and
 - (d) You will produce evidence of any required consents, agreements, permissions and waivers at the Society's request.

13. If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, the Society may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the competition.
14. The Society reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the prize competition where it becomes necessary to do so.

Insofar as is permitted by law, the Society will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate winners or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up a prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Society. Your statutory rights are not affected.
16. These terms and conditions shall be governed by English law, and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
