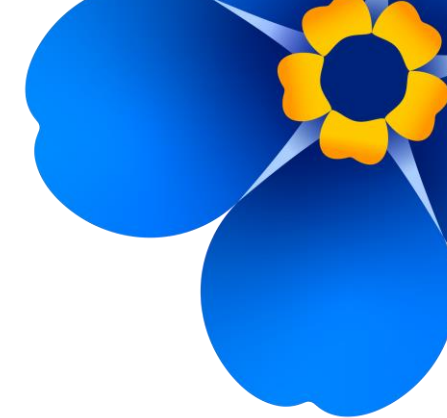
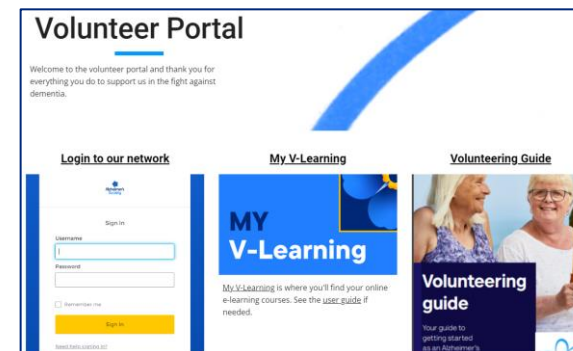


How to: Log into MYV-Learning

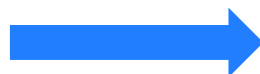


- 1 Access MYV-Learning, either via the **volunteer portal** or by going to: myvlearning.alzheimers.org.uk/account/Login

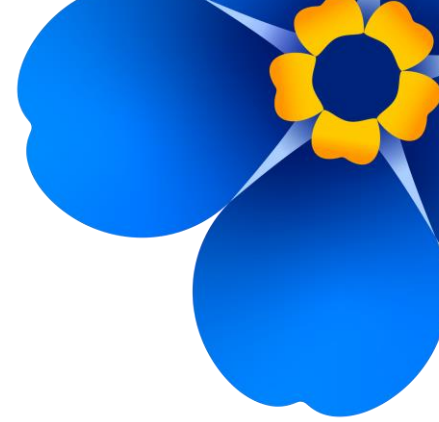
- a If you do, use the blue **'single sign on'** box to log in.



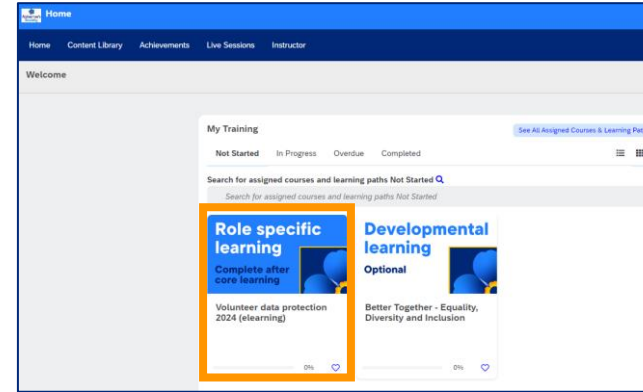

- b If you don't, use the **'username'** and **'password'** fields. If you can't remember your details, click the 'I've forgotten' button to check or reset them.

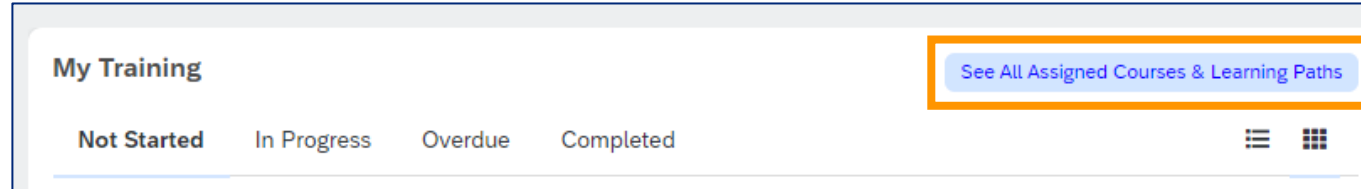
How to: Find a course



1 Once you've logged in, check your dashboard to see if the course you need is visible.



2 If you can't see it, click on 'See all assigned courses & learning paths'



3 Search for a **key word** (for example, you might try 'data' for data protection).
Make sure none of the **filters** on the left are ticked too.
